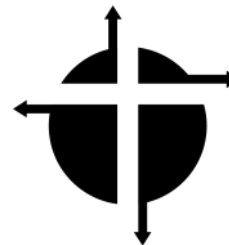

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES TO DRIVE-IN CHURCH:

- A printed lyric sheet is being handed out along with this informational sheet (bulletin) as you drive in. If you are uncomfortable receiving a sheet due to COVID-19, you are free and welcome to decline it.
- We welcome people to bring lawn chairs. You are welcome to sit around your vehicle. We have the front section of the parking lot blocked off for an outdoor group seating area as well. There are cones around the area to help you see this. The P.A. system will broadcast the service in the parking lot.
- We do ask that everyone respect each other's distance if they wish, and decisions in regard to outdoor seating, being mindful of those who choose to remain in their vehicles or only sitting around their cars. The church will continue to be closed and we heavily encourage you to plan not to use the restrooms here at HCC.

A WORD FROM THE CONSISTORY:

The Consistory has set a **Target Date** for resuming in-person worship inside the church. **We are aiming for September 13.** This is also the day we will kick-off our discipleship season. The Consistory will be meeting on August 17, 2020.
