

Reopening Church Survey Results

63 Submissions

- 61 / 63 from church “partners” (members)
- 2 guests
- *137 people represented in responses*

How Eager are you to “reopen”

- 1 – Five (6 people) 4.4%
- 2 – Four (8 people) 5.8%
- 3 – Nine (23 people) 16.8%
- 4 – Eleven (21 people) 15.3%
- 5 – Thirty-Four (79 people) 57.7%

“In-person” comfort level

- Extremely Comfortable – 25 (55 people) 40.1%
- Fairly Comfortable – 22 (46 people) 33.6%
- Neutral – 6 (16 people) 11.7%
- Fairly Uncomfortable – 7 (12 people) 8.8%
- Extremely Uncomfortable – 3 (8 people) 5.8%

“Re-opening” and Division

- Multiple Services – 9 (21 people) 15.3%
 - “Several identical services at different times”
- Multiple Venues – 35 (72 people) 52.6%
 - “One service, multiple simultaneous) *PLANNED* gatherings”
- Continue Drive-in Church – 19 (32.1% people)
 - “I think its more important that we meet together”

If HCC reopens in September:

- 51 respondents would attend
 - 111 people (81%)
- 12 respondents would watch the livestream
 - 26 people (19%)

If HCC continues drive-in in Sept:

- 49 respondents would attend
 - 99 people (72.2%)
- 13 respondents would watch the livestream
 - 36 people (26.2%)
- 1 respondent would stop coming to church
 - 2 people (1.5%)

Opinions about what we should do:

- Continue to follow state/federal recommendations:
 - 19 respondents (37 people) 37%
- Reopen ASAP:
 - 24 respondents (50 people) 36.5%
- Alternative Service Options:
 - 9 respondents (20 people) 14.6%
- No Opinion:
 - 10 respondents (28 people) 20.4%
- Go to “all online” format
 - 1 Respondent (2 people) 1.5%

Comparisons: Eagerness

- **1 – Five (6 people) 4.4%** vs. *6.7% in May*
- **2 – Four (8 people) 5.8%** vs. *8.3 % in May*
- **3 – Nine (23 people) 16.8%** vs. *15% in May*
- **4 – Eleven (21 people) 15.3%** vs. *25% in May*
- **5 – Thirty-Four (79 people) 57.7%** vs. *41.7% in May*

Comparisons: Comfort

- Extremely Comfortable – 25 (55 people) 40.1%
 - *Vs. 26.67% in May*
- Fairly Comfortable – 22 (46 people) 33.6%
 - *Vs. 28.33% in May*
- Neutral – 6 (16 people) 11.7%
 - *Vs. 15% in May*
- Fairly Uncomfortable – 7 (12 people) 8.8%
 - *Vs. 21.67% in May*
- Extremely Uncomfortable – 3 (8 people) 5.8%
 - *Vs. 8.33% in May*

Comparisons: Service Options

- Multiple Services – 9 (21 people) 15.3%
 - *Vs. 26.26% in May*
- Multiple Venues – 35 (72 people) 52.6%
 - *Vs. 35% in May*
- Continue Drive-in Church – 19 (32.1% people)
 - *Vs. 38.88% in May*

Comparisons: If HCC reopens in...

- *...June*

- 45 / 60 would attend (75%)
- 15/60 would watch the livestream (25%)

- *...September*

- 51 respondents would attend
 - 111 people (81%)
- 12 respondents would watch the livestream
 - 26 people (19%)

Comparisons: If HCC continues drive-in in...

- *...June*

- 53 / 60 would attend (88.33%)
- 4/60 would watch the livestream (6.67%)
- 3/60 other**

- *...September*

- 49 respondents would attend
 - 99 people (72.2%)
- 13 respondents would watch the livestream
 - 36 people (26.2%)
- 1 respondent would stop coming to church
 - 2 people (1.5%)

Comparisons: Opinions

- Continue to follow state/federal recommendations:
 - 19 respondents (37 people) 37% vs 61.67% in May
- Reopen ASAP:
 - 24 respondents (50 people) 36.5% vs 21.67% in May
- Alternative Service Options:
 - 9 respondents (20 people) 14.6% vs 8.33% in May
- No Opinion:
 - 10 respondents (28 people) 20.4% vs 8.33% in May
- Go to “all online” format
 - 1 Respondent (2 people) 1.5% vs. 0% in May

Pause...

- What strikes you about these results?
- What do you find encouraging or discouraging?

Responses regarding Masks:

- **“I am comfortable letting people choose”**
 - 48 respondents (107 people) 78.1%
- **“I will only attend if everyone wears a mask”**
 - 11 respondents (21 people) 15.3%
- **“I will not attend if we are forced to wear masks”**
 - 1 respondent (2 people) 1.5%
- **“Separate area where masks are required”**
 - 3 respondents (7 people) 5.1%

“Is the Church responsible for providing masks?”

- **Yes**

- 1 respondent (2 people) 1.5%

- **No**

- 57 respondents (123 people) 89.8%

- **Unsure**

- 5 respondents (12 people) 8.8%

Responses regarding Discipleship Hour:*

- **Attend Myself (58 people)**
- **Send my Children (51 people)**
- **Wait until I/we are more comfortable (21 people)**
- **Not attend due to COVID-19 concerns (9 people)**
- **Not attend for other reasons (28 people)**

Likelihood of parents sending kids to discipleship ministry options this fall:

- **Likely will send**
 - 22 respondents (46 people) 33.6%
- **Likely will not send**
 - 1 respondent (4 people) 2.9%
- **Not applicable**
 - 40 respondents (87 people) 63.5%

Responses regarding Discipleship Ministries:*

- **Walk out Worship** (4 respondents)
- **Discipleship Hour** (20 respondents)
- **GEMS** (11 respondents)
- **Cadets** (16 respondents)
- **Middle School Youth Group** (19 respondents)
- **High School Youth Group** (8 respondents)
