## QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

WEEK OF FEBRUARY 21, 2021

---

1. During the days of Elijah, the nation of Israel (Northern Kingdom) fell away from the LORD in a time of national apostasy! Instead of obeying the LORD, they began to follow Baal. Sometimes we think we are immune from this kind of religious syncretism (thinking we are following God – yet adding Baal worship). Jesus warns us that we cannot serve both God and money, or fully love God and love the world (its attitudes & values) at the same time. How might we guard our hearts from this kind of deception today?
2. Read through 1 Kings 17 & 18 once again and note the RADICAL prayers that Elijah prayed and the impact his prayers had on the nation of Israel. The key to praying radically is developing intimacy with the LORD and HEARING the voice of the Holy Spirit, and then praying boldly what you know God wants. What can you begin to do this week to foster greater intimacy with our Lord?
3. One of the first major goals in our HCC Vision is to meet our neighbors in the Village of Hopkins. Go for a drive (or two) this week through the various neighborhoods of the village. Ask the Lord to give you His 'eyes' to see things here the way He does. Listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. What do you see and hear? What do you sense spiritually as you do this? Now pray for the Village of Hopkins according to God's desires for the people living here.
